  - Mr. Roberts is CEO of <u>CAP Yarns, Inc.</u>, based in Clover, South Carolina. CAP Yarns is a
    specialty yarn manufacturer and a leader in developing unique yarns for the knitting and
    weaving industry.

NCTO is a Washington, DC-based trade association that represents domestic textile manufacturers.

- U.S. employment in the textile supply chain was 594,147 in 2018.
- The value of shipments for U.S. textiles and apparel was \$76.8 billion in 2018.
- U.S. exports of fiber, textiles and apparel were \$30.1 billion in 2018.
- Capital expenditures for textile and apparel production totaled \$2.0 billion in 2017, the last year for which data is available.
